P.T.M. – III

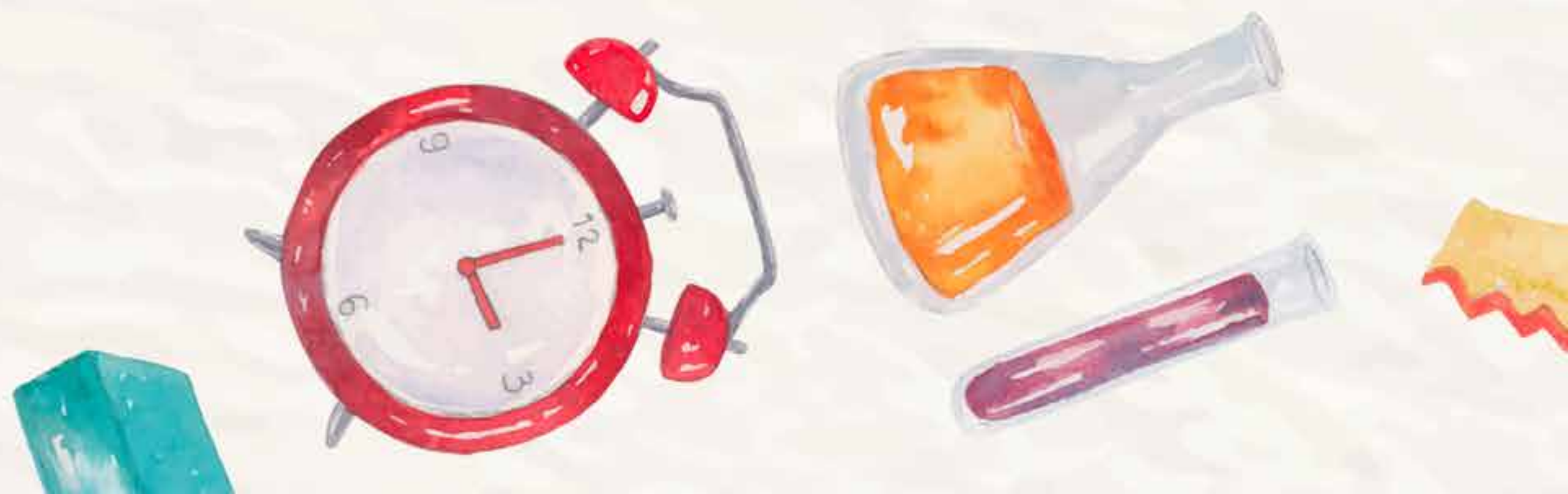
