A TRUE PATRIOT & NATIONAL HERO

The Nation owes a 'Posthumous Collective Apology' to the Late Dr.Abdul Quadeer Khan, who, because of his concern for the safety and security of his beloved country, steadfastly struggled to convince Pakistan's rulers about the absolute necessity of a nuclear deterrent to neutralize the edge of forces hostile to our very existence. Having cleared this hurdle, he assembled a team of Pakistani scientists to design a nuclear program that would eventually lead to the development of indigenous nuclear capability.
