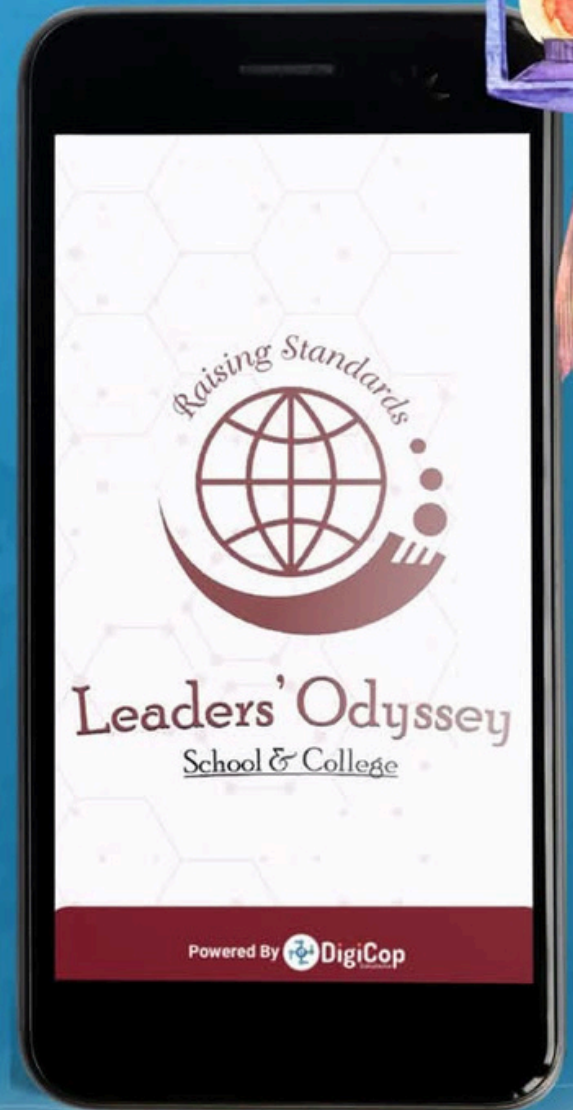
By downloading the CMS App, both the Parents and Students can access any pertinent information related to a student's involvement in school activities, academic and non-academic, plus other relevant data.

# Classroom Protocols

Students are expected to keep a dignified presence in class by subscribing to the following, at all times:
