At LOSC, we believe that academic excellence must go hand in hand with character development. As such, manners and courtesy are integral components of our student assessment policy. Students are regularly observed and evaluated on their behavior, attitude, and interpersonal interactions as part of their overall development. The objectives of our student assessment policy on manners and courtesy are to foster a respectful and inclusive environment, develop students' social and emotional intelligence, and encourage them to embody kindness, empathy, and humility in their daily lives. Students are assessed on several key indicators that reflect these values.

These include respectful communication, such as speaking politely to teachers, peers, and support staff; demonstrating proper classroom etiquette by raising hands before speaking, listening attentively, and following instructions; and showing kindness and empathy by helping others, understanding different perspectives, and avoiding hurtful behavior. Additionally, students are encouraged to express gratitude through courteous expressions like "please," "thank you," and "excuse me," and to show respect for space and property by taking care of school materials and maintaining cleanliness.






SCHOOL TIMINGS DURING EXAMINATION
