




SCHOOL RULES

- 1. Celebration of Birthdays at School is not encouraged. However, Parents/Guardians may send tidbits for sharing, e.g., candies or cookies etc.
- 2. Music is not promoted at School.
- 3. Notebooks/textbooks must not be lent to fellows without the permission of the subject teacher.
- 4. Teachers or staff members are not allowed to receive money or materialistic gifts from students or Parents/Guardians. However, students or parents may extend a card or letter of appreciation to honor the efforts of the teachers/staff.
- 5. If a child has an accident or becomes ill at School, parents will be notified immediately and, if required, will be asked to take the child home. In case of an emergency, the School's staff will take the child immediately to the hospital. The emergency contact will be notified promptly.
- 6. Students must communicate to each other using terms like Brother or Sister.



SCHOOL RULES

- 7. We promote healthy dietary habits and have a "No Junk Food" Policy. It is emphasized that students bring healthy and wholesome foods such as fruits, vegetables, dates, sandwiches etc. Please avoid sending junk food such as soft drinks, chocolates, sweets, packed crisps etc. It is advised that parents encourage a lifestyle of healthy eating for children at home as well.
- 8. Parents/Guardians shall not be allowed to interfere in the affairs of the School's discipline, administration, teaching methods, and co-curricular activities incorporated at the School. Concerns must be clarified before the start of the Academic Year.
- 9. Students are expected to come to the School with all required items. Lunch, water bottle, stationery items etc. are not received from Parents/Guardians during school hours.
