STEAM INTRODUCTION & ITS 15 DOMAINS

We are excited to introduce STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) education at our school. This program aims to provide students with hands-on, inquiry-based learning that connects classroom knowledge with real-world problem-solving. Through STEAM, students will explore creativity alongside scientific thinking, preparing them for future innovation.

STEAM education is divided into 15 domains which include robotics, artificial intelligence, coding, 3D printing, design thinking, renewable energy, electronics, space science, biomedical engineering, digital media, environmental science, mechanical systems, architecture, chemistry innovation, and mathematics applications. These domains will be gradually introduced in the school to inspire curiosity and innovation among students.
