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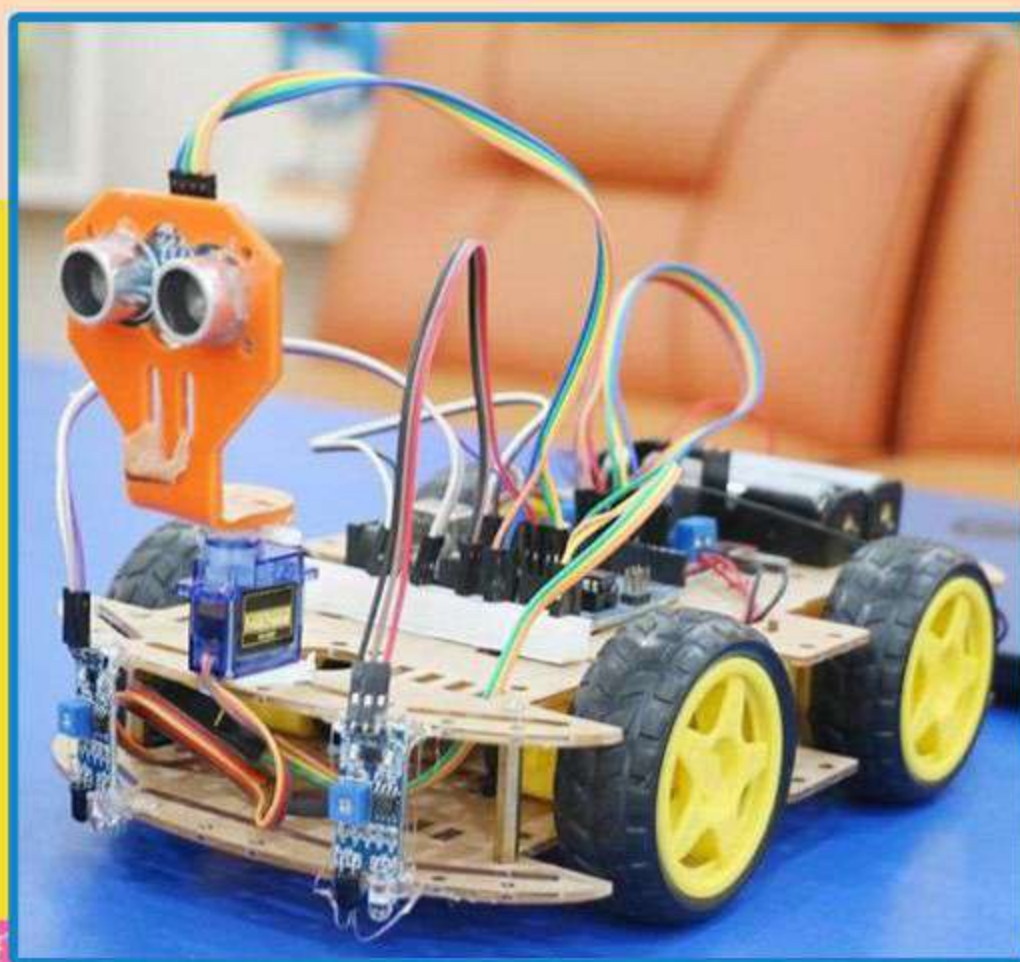
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STEM TRAINING FOR SELECTED TEACHERS

PERSONAL APPEARANCE & HEALTHY HABITS

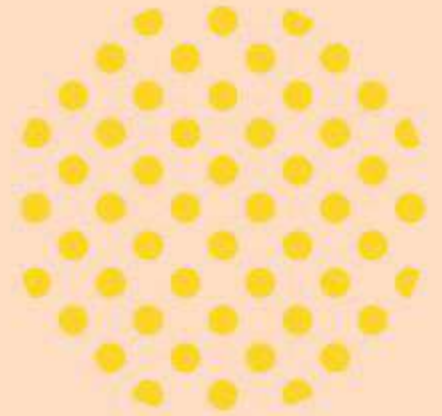

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ADMISSIONS 2026 SIBLINGS PRIORITY

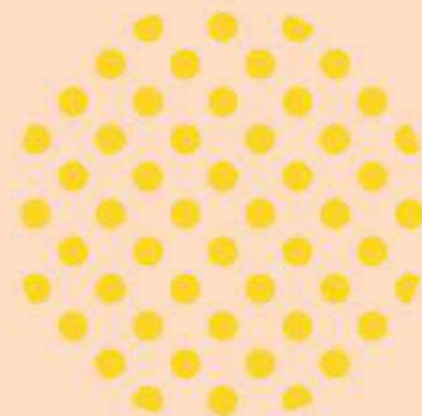

Through this platform, students will gain leadership experience, represent their peers, and contribute meaningfully to school life. We look forward to their initiatives in the coming months.

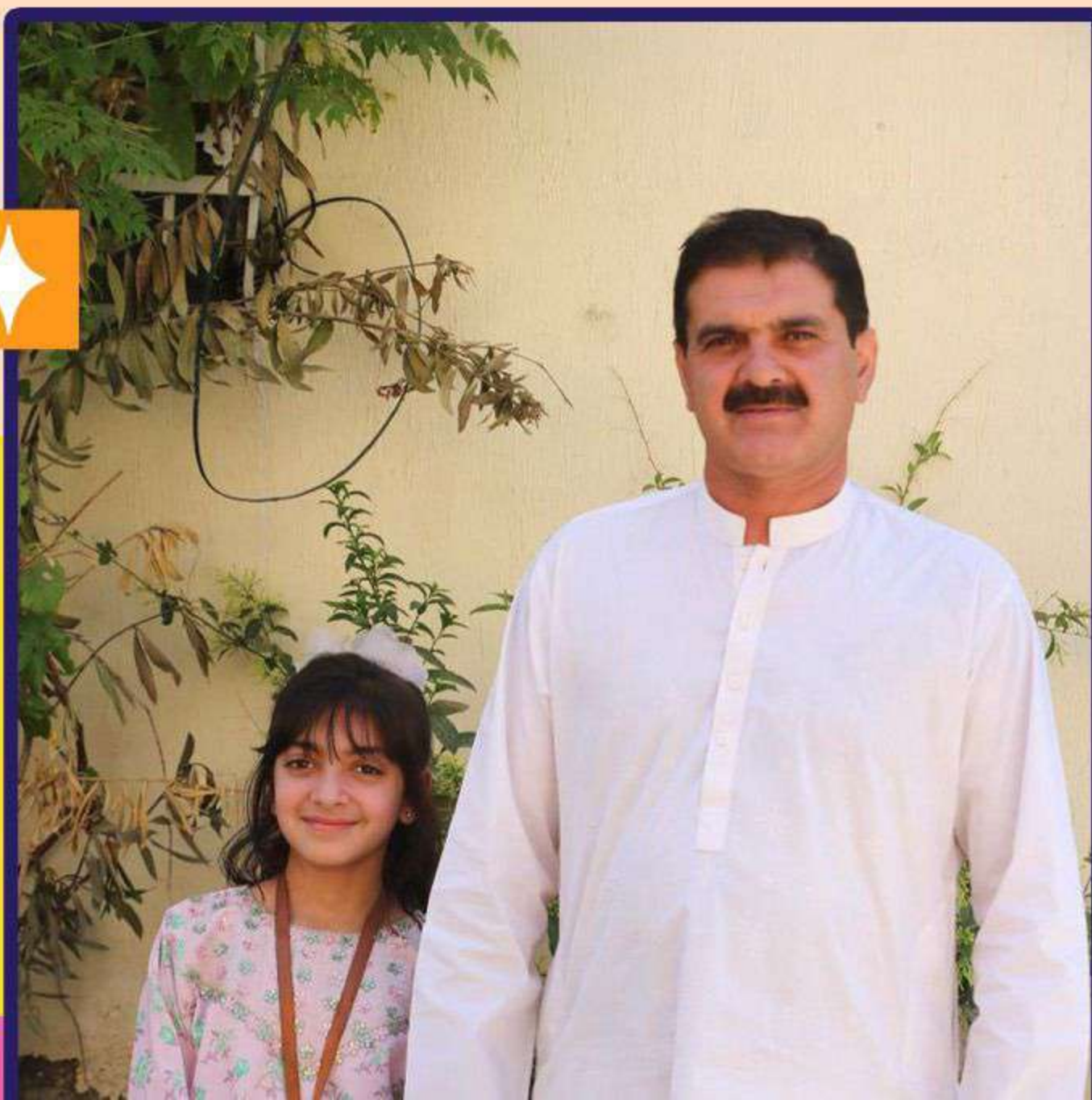




4TH PARENT-TEACHER MEETING (PTM)
