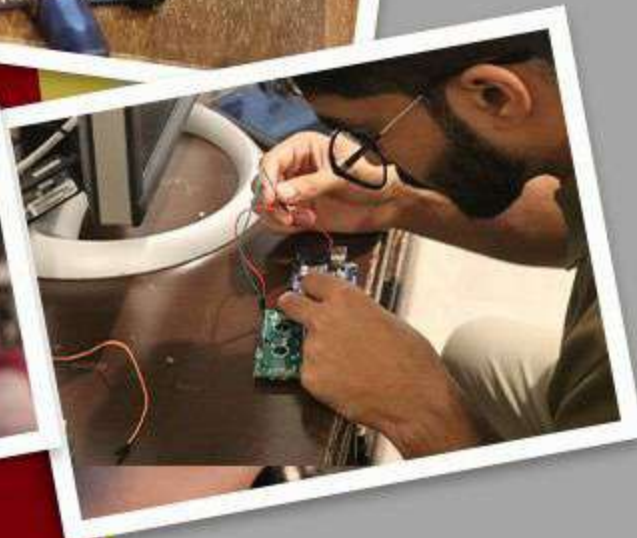
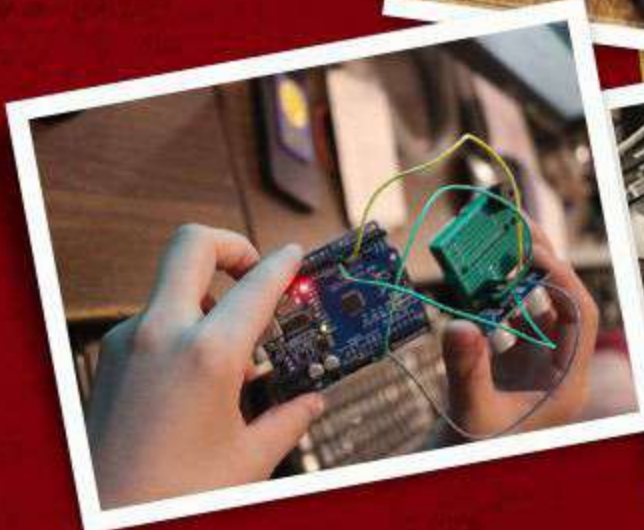
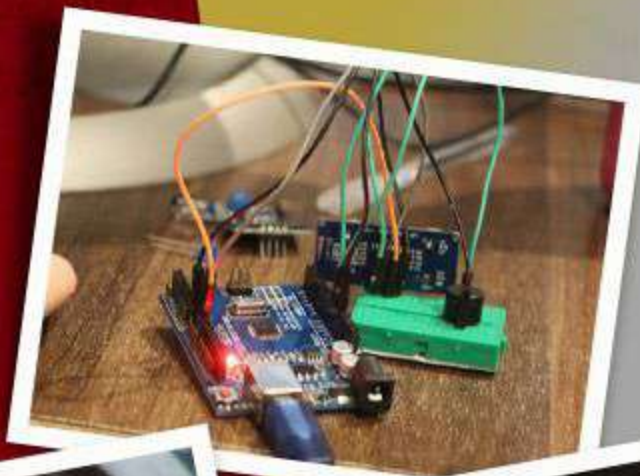
Teachers will integrate related activities inside the classroom, promoting confidence, listening skills, and respectful dialogue. Parents are also encouraged to reinforce these values at home.
