Students will enjoy fun-filled activities, games, and treats organized by their teachers. Parents are requested to ensure that students come prepared according to the theme communicated by the class teacher.





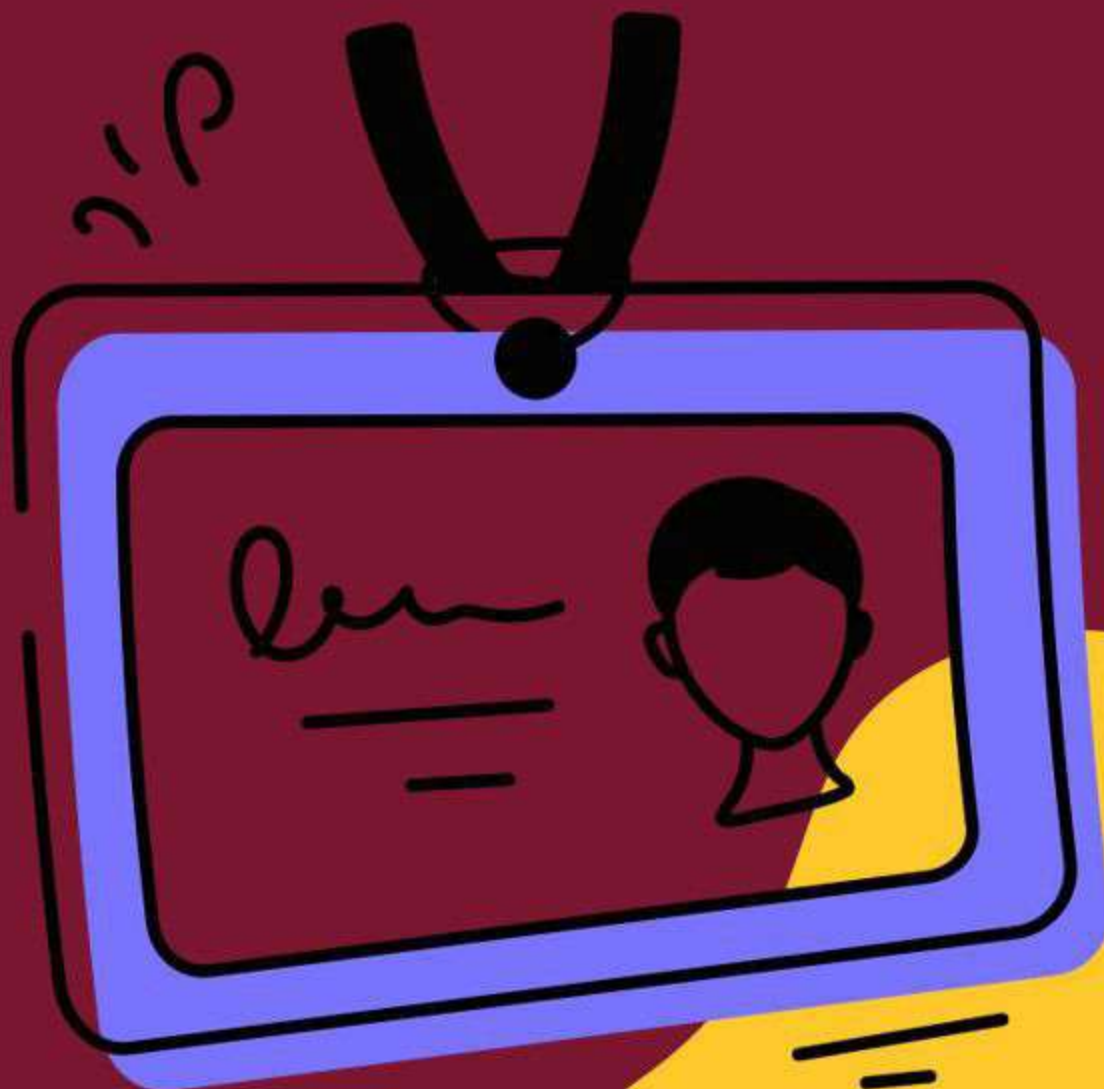
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ID CARDS PICTURES 2026

Teachers will begin term-end revisions soon, so students must stay attentive and punctual. Parents' cooperation in ensuring consistent attendance is greatly appreciated.

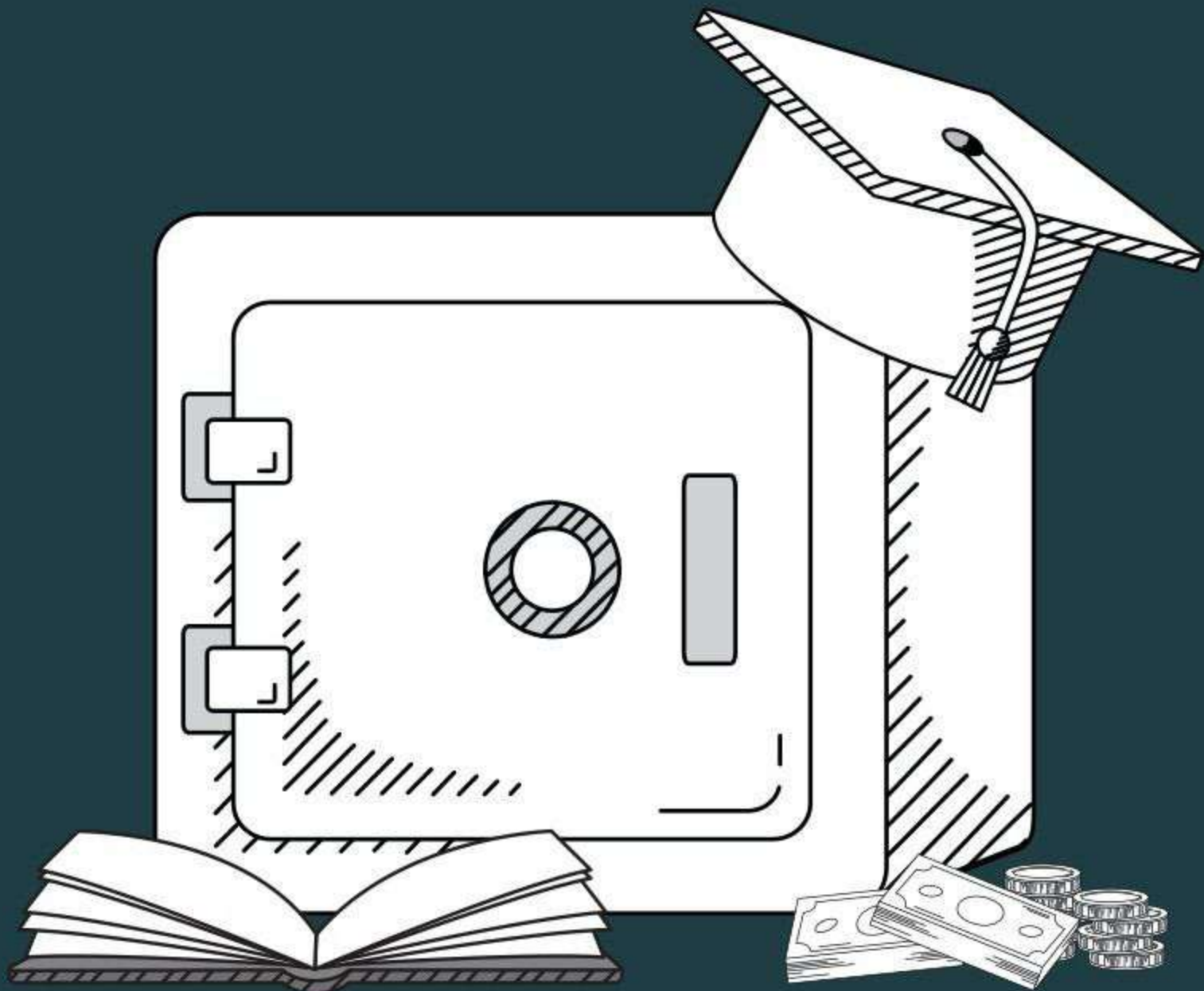
The school emphasizes that every missed day is a missed opportunity to learn something valuable. Let's finish the term strong!
