


WEEKLY NEWSLETTER

This decision will be made based on the individual student's overall academic record.







EXAMINATION RULES

- Communication with fellow candidates prohibited.
- Complete all your details in the relevant spaces before starting the test.
- Review your answer-sheet before exiting.
- •Calculators permitted only for Grades VI, VII & VIII.
- Maintain discipline in the exam hall.
- Any student indulging in unfair means will be dealt with as per school rules and policies.
- ·Water-bottle allowed.









November Voucher: Covers the months of November and December 2025. Payment is due in November (dual payment for both months).

December Voucher: Covers the months of January and February 2026. Payment is due in December (dual payment for both months).

Dues Deadline: Dues must be cleared on or before the 6th of every month.

Consequences of Non-Payment: If the fee is not paid, the student will not be allowed to sit for exams and may suffer consequences related to final papers.

We appreciate your support in strengthening school-parent communication.






PASSING CRITERIA - 40%

Regular practice and guidance can greatly improve student performance.






AITCHISON COLLEGE EVENT JANUARY


Aitchison College has once again invited our school to participate in their upcoming event in January. This is a valuable opportunity for students to gain exposure and confidence.

The feedback received from parents has been very positive and encouraging, helping us improve future student activities.












