




CMS APP DOWNLOAD






RAMADAN 3RD ASHRA DUA

After the completion of Ramadan, the school will resume its regular academic timing. Parents and students are requested to ensure punctual attendance according to the normal school schedule.


Maintaining punctuality helps students remain consistent with their learning routines and supports a well-organized academic environment.
