ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE & POLICIES

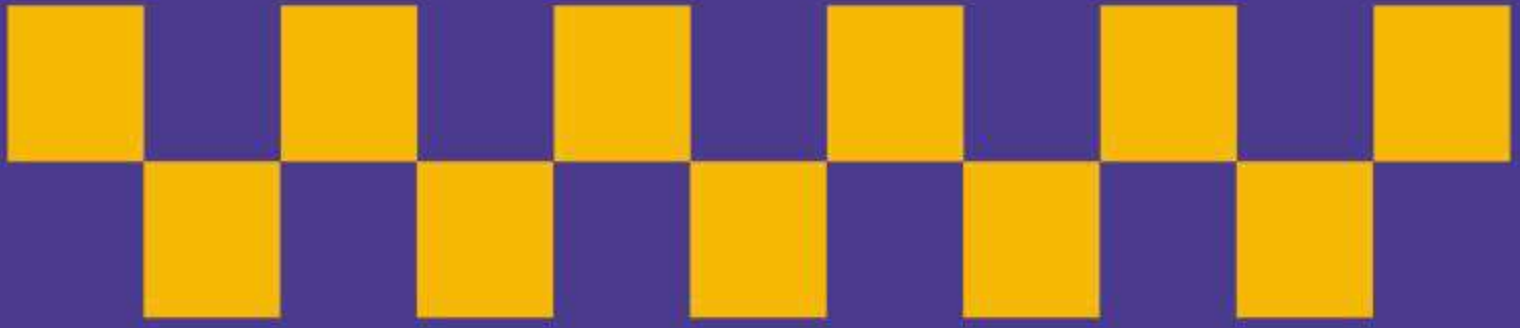
