We encourage parents to stay connected with the school and support their children in maintaining discipline and academic focus.

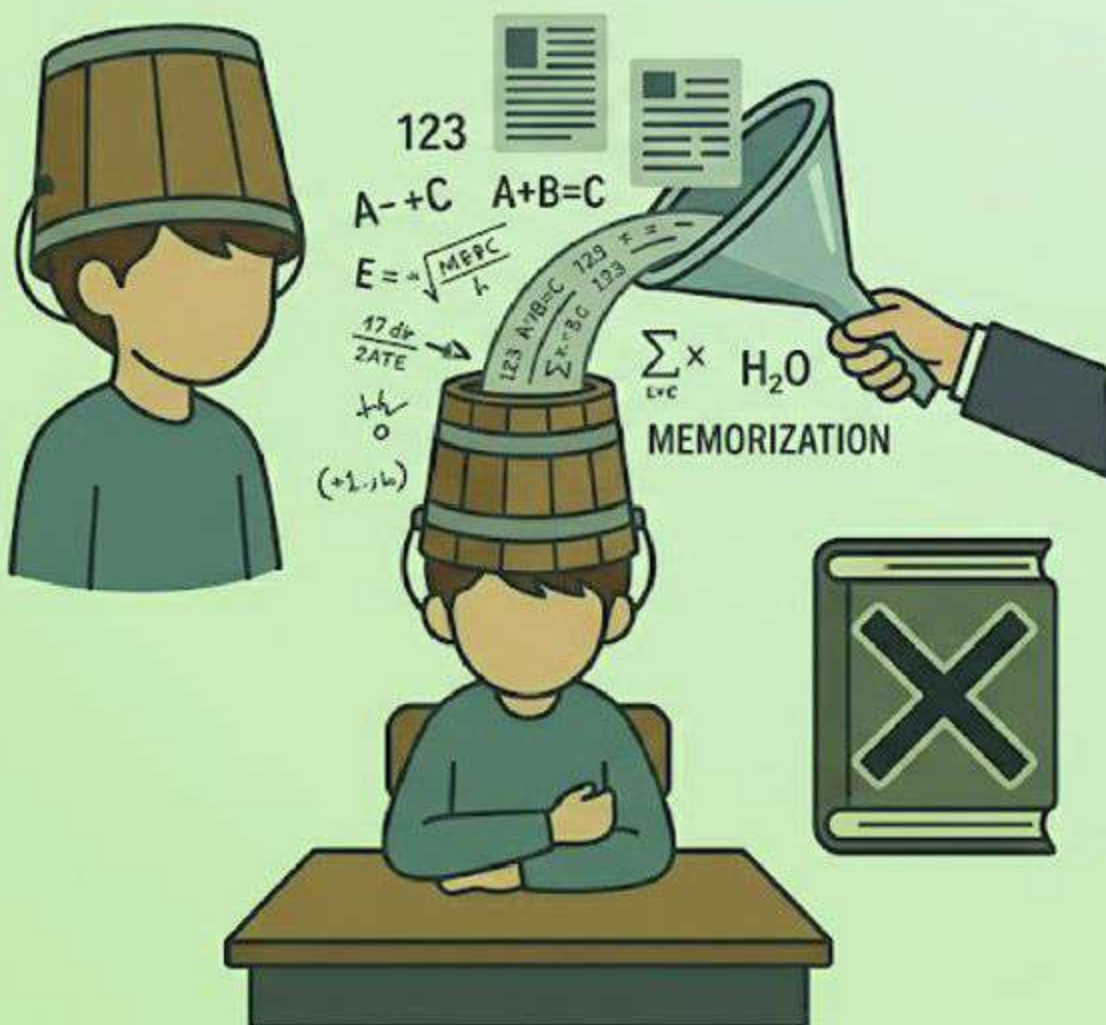
