

We are pleased to announce the introduction of German language classes across all senior sections. This initiative aims to equip students with an additional global language, opening pathways to international education and career opportunities.

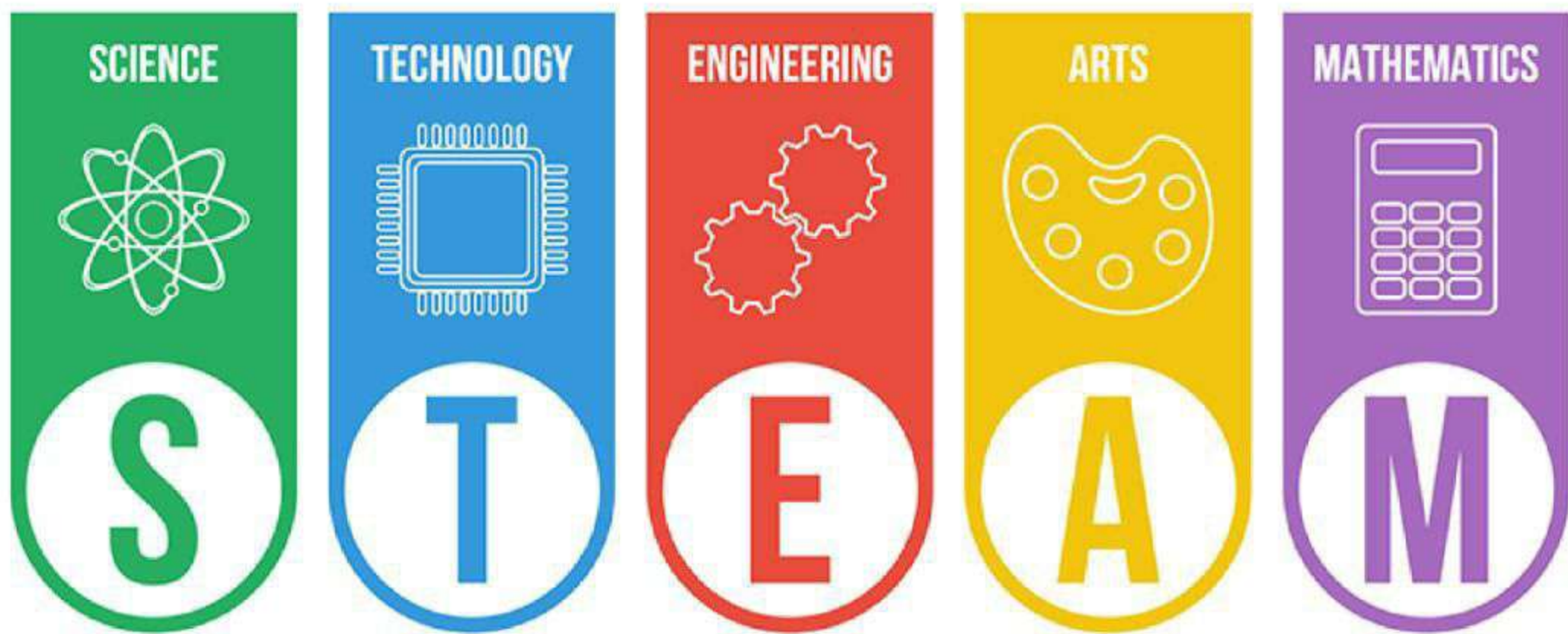
Learning a new language enhances cognitive ability, cultural awareness, and communication skills. This program reflects our commitment to preparing students for a globally connected future.

This approach ensures that students are not only academically capable but also adaptable, confident, and prepared to face future challenges.



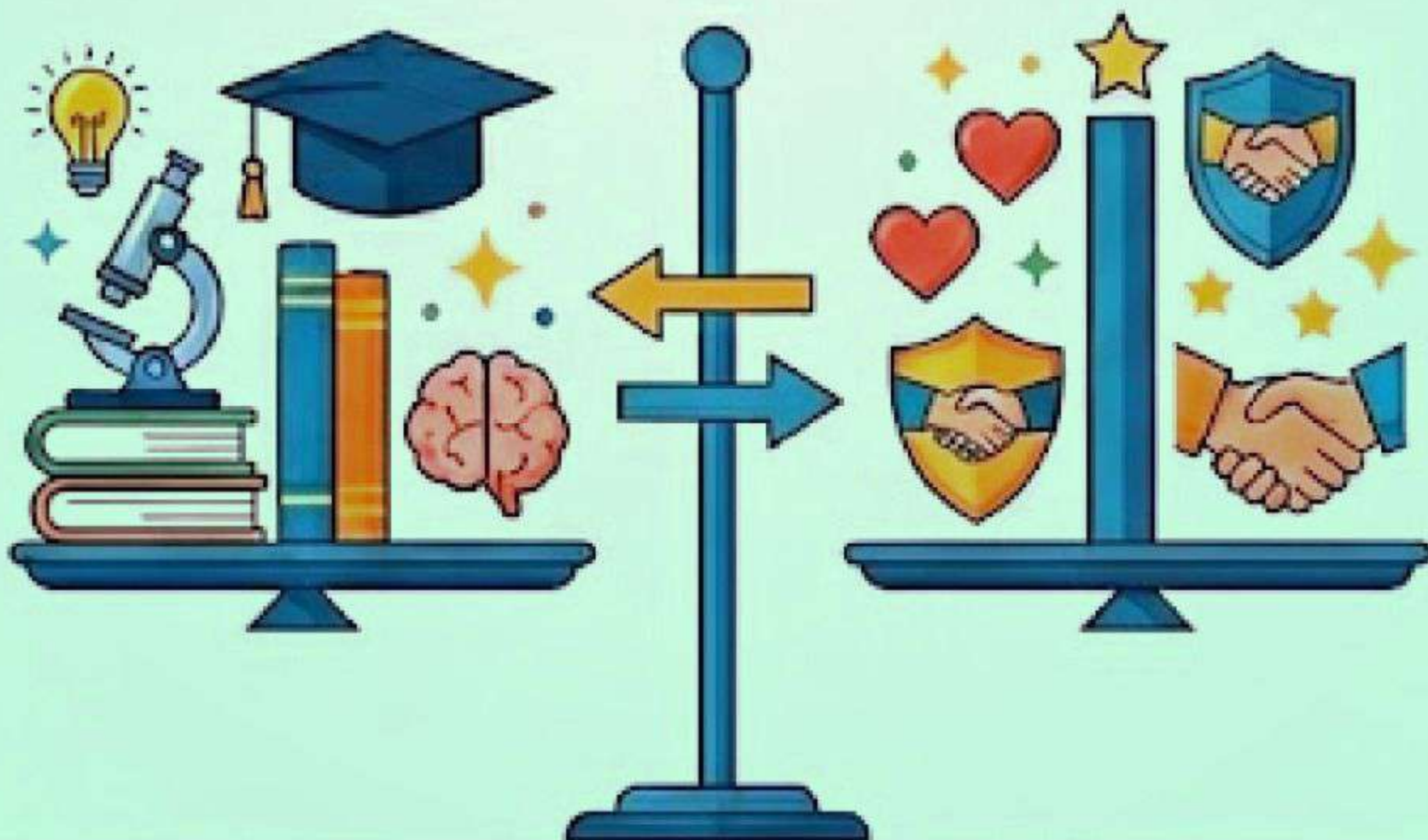


# CHARACTER BUILDING & STUDENT DEVELOPMENT

Regular attendance plays a vital role in academic performance, and adherence to policies helps maintain a structured and effective learning environment.

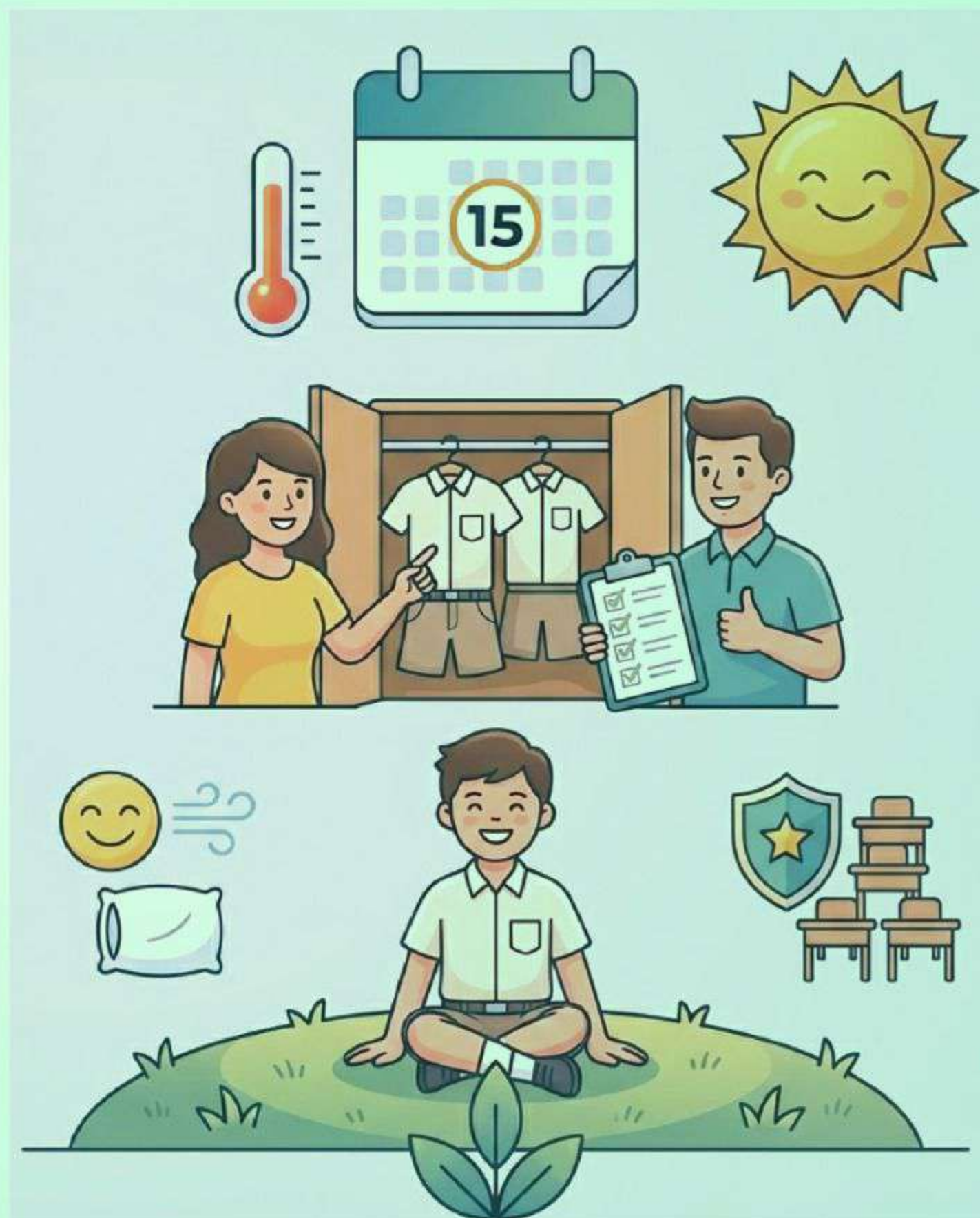


# SUMMER UNIFORM SEASONAL TRANSITION
