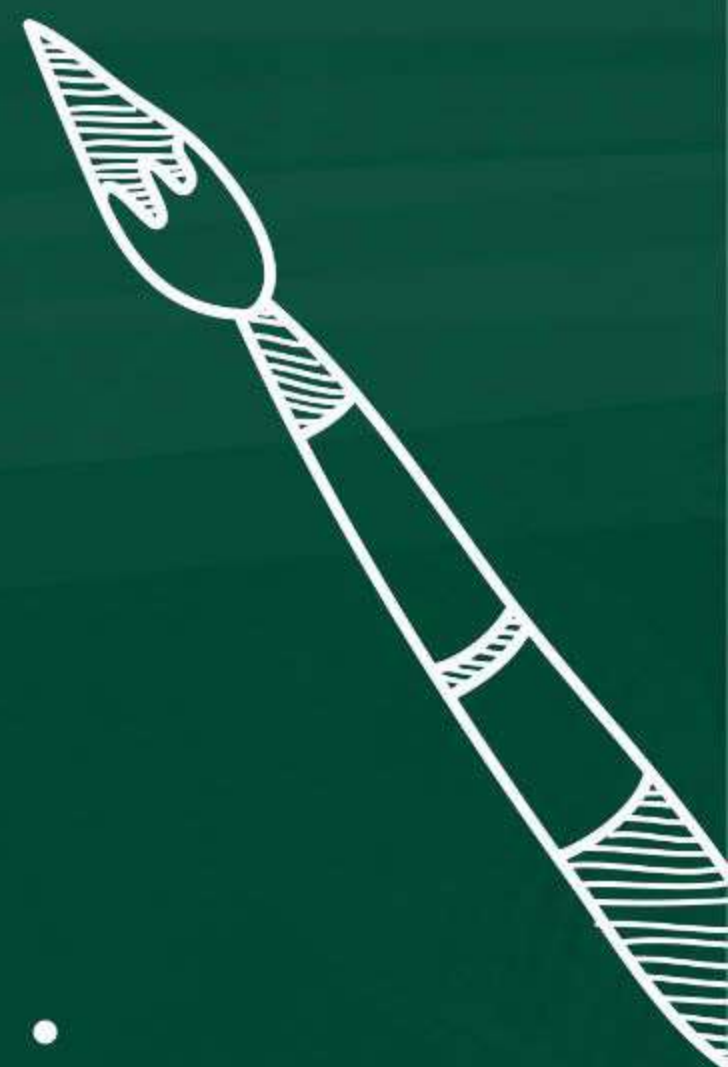


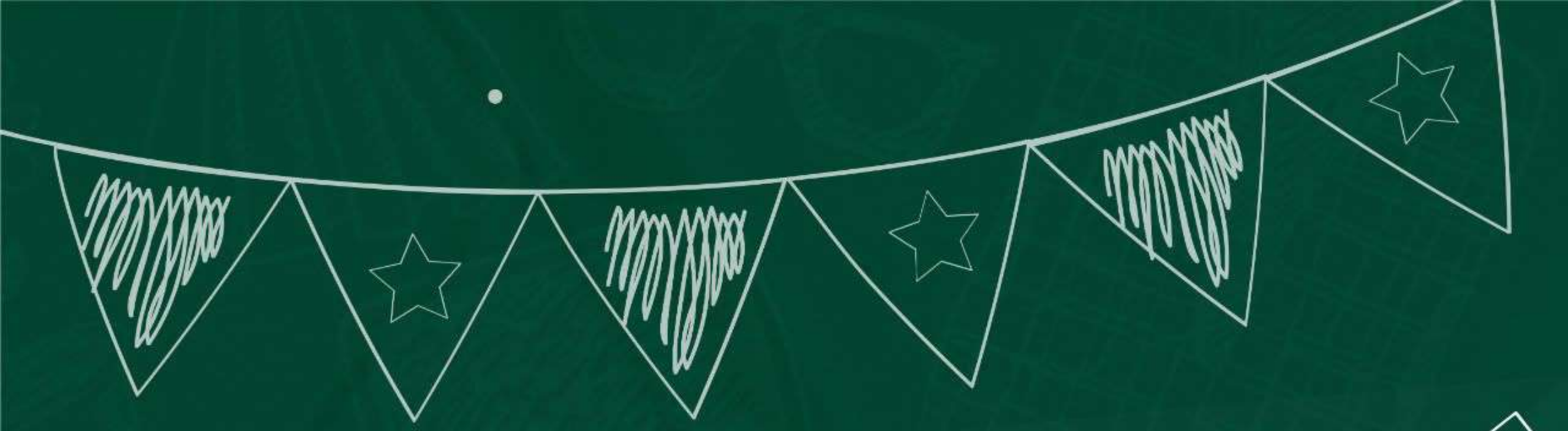

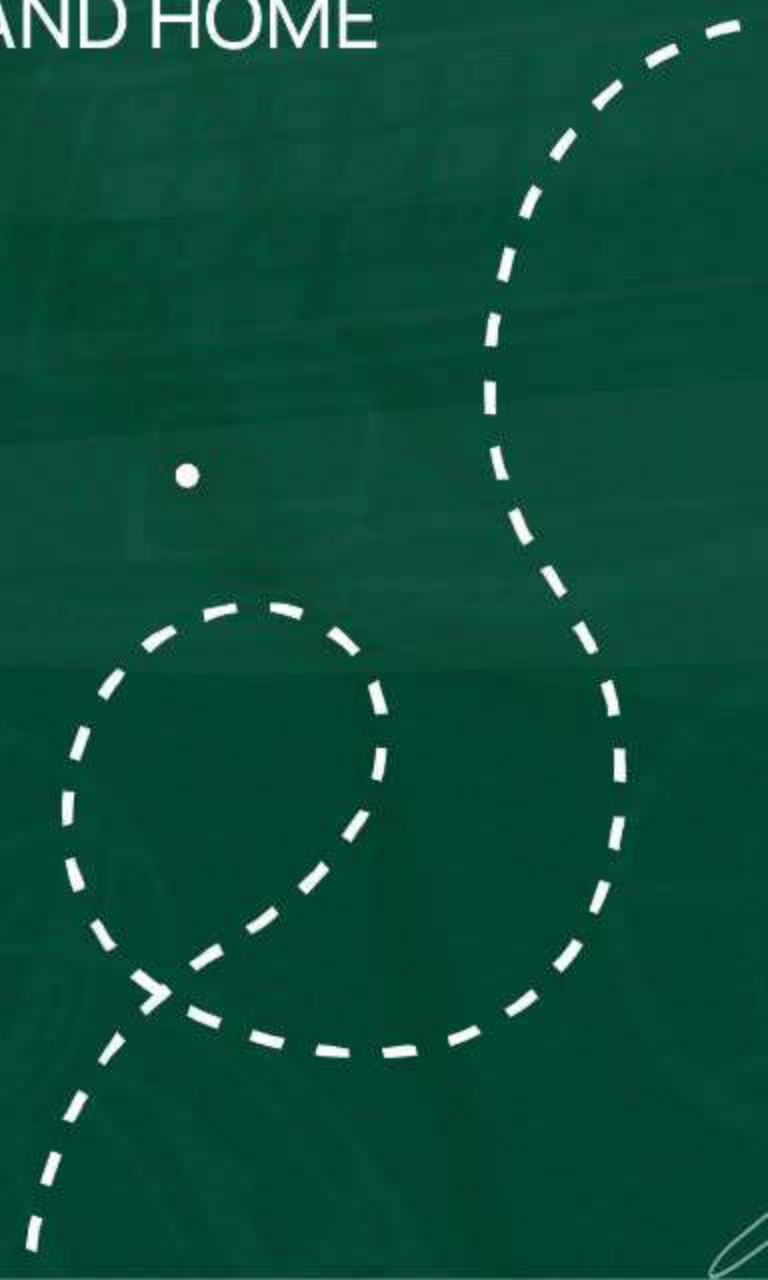
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THE VALUE OF PUNCTUALITY

SCHOOL RULES

1. The school encourages a respectful, disciplined, and healthy learning environment for every student.
2. Birthday celebrations are not observed on campus, however, parents may send small treats such as candies or cookies for classmates.
3. Books or notebooks should not be exchanged without a teacher's permission.
4. Teachers and staff are unable to accept gifts or money, although appreciation cards and letters are always welcomed.
5. Students are expected to address one another as Brother or Sister.
6. Follow the school's No Junk Food policy by bringing healthy lunches.
7. Parents are requested not to interfere in school discipline or academic procedures.
8. Ensure students arrive with all necessary belongings, including lunch, water bottles, and stationery, as these cannot be delivered during school hours.
9. In case of illness or injury, parents will be informed immediately. During emergencies, the school will arrange medical assistance while contacting parents without delay.





WITHDRAWAL **PROCEDURE**

Parents wishing to withdraw their child from the school must submit written notice at least one month in advance. If the required notice is not provided, one month's school fee shall be payable in lieu of notice.

The Withdrawal Certificate will be issued within one week after the required formalities have been completed.

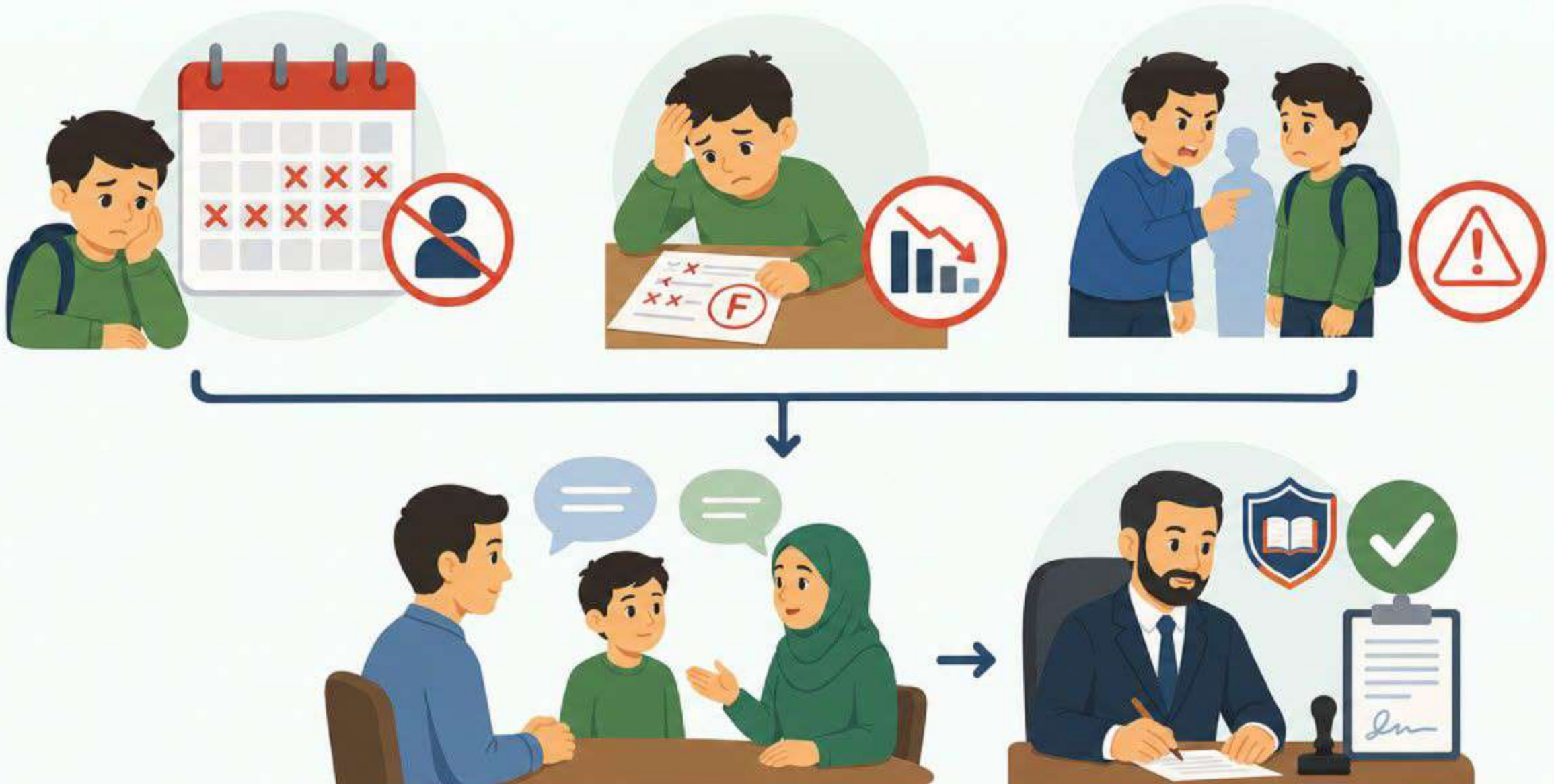




EXPULSION POLICY

The school reserves the right to request the withdrawal of a student due to prolonged unauthorised absence, repeated academic failure, or serious disciplinary concerns.

Before a final decision is made, the student and their parents will be given an opportunity to present their explanation. The final decision of the School Head shall be binding.





FEE AND MONETARY REGULATIONS

The school reserves the right to revise tuition fees and other applicable charges whenever necessary. Fees are non-transferable and non-refundable, and students admitted during any academic month shall be charged the full monthly fee.

Fees for January and February must be paid before the annual result card is issued. Penalties may be imposed for damage to school property, while fundraising activities for charitable causes will be conducted only through official school notifications.

A tuition fee concession of 25% is available for the third sibling and each additional sibling, in accordance with the school's policy.





SCHOOL FEE **SCHEDULE**

Fee vouchers are issued on the 28th of each month and are payable by the 6th of the following month. A late-payment surcharge of Rs. 1,000 will apply after the due date. Payment dates may be adjusted if they coincide with public holidays.

All fees should be deposited through the School Accounts Department. Duplicate report cards are issued upon written request for a fee of Rs. 500, while replacement ID cards and exit cards are available for Rs. 400 each.
