SECOND TERM EXAMINATION SYLLABUS

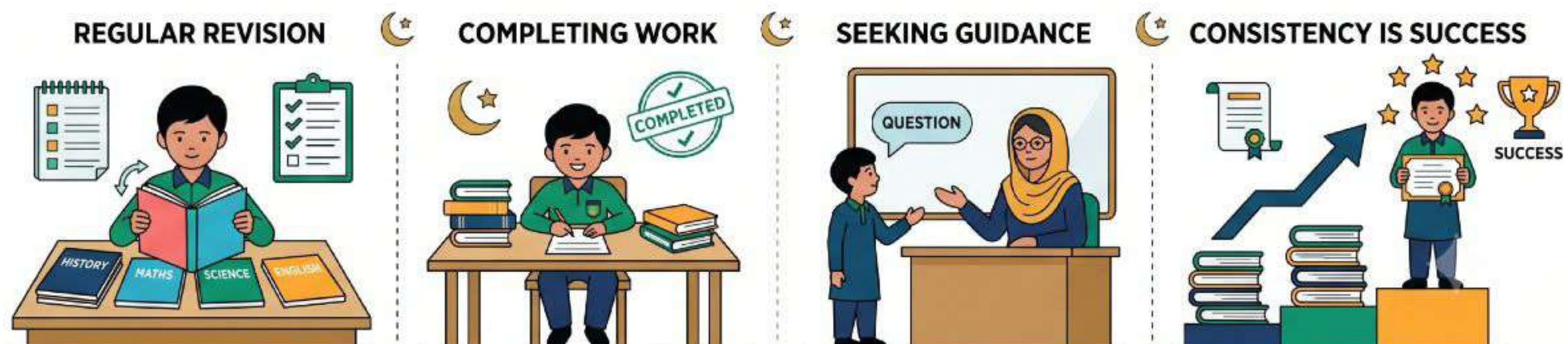
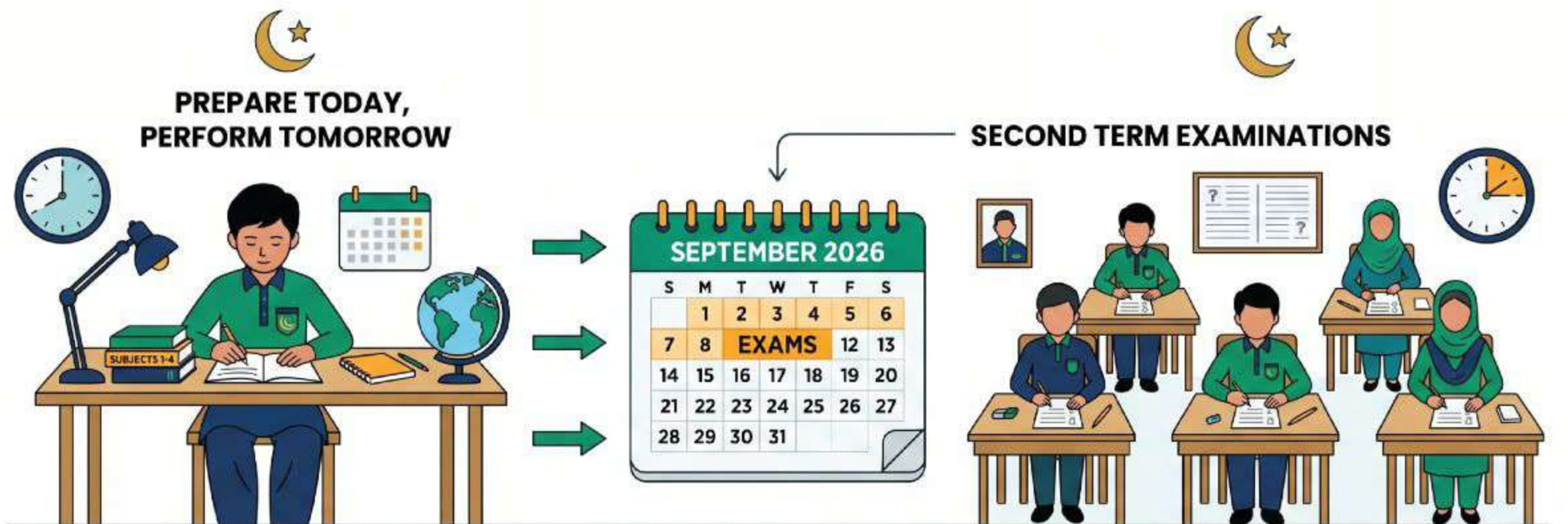

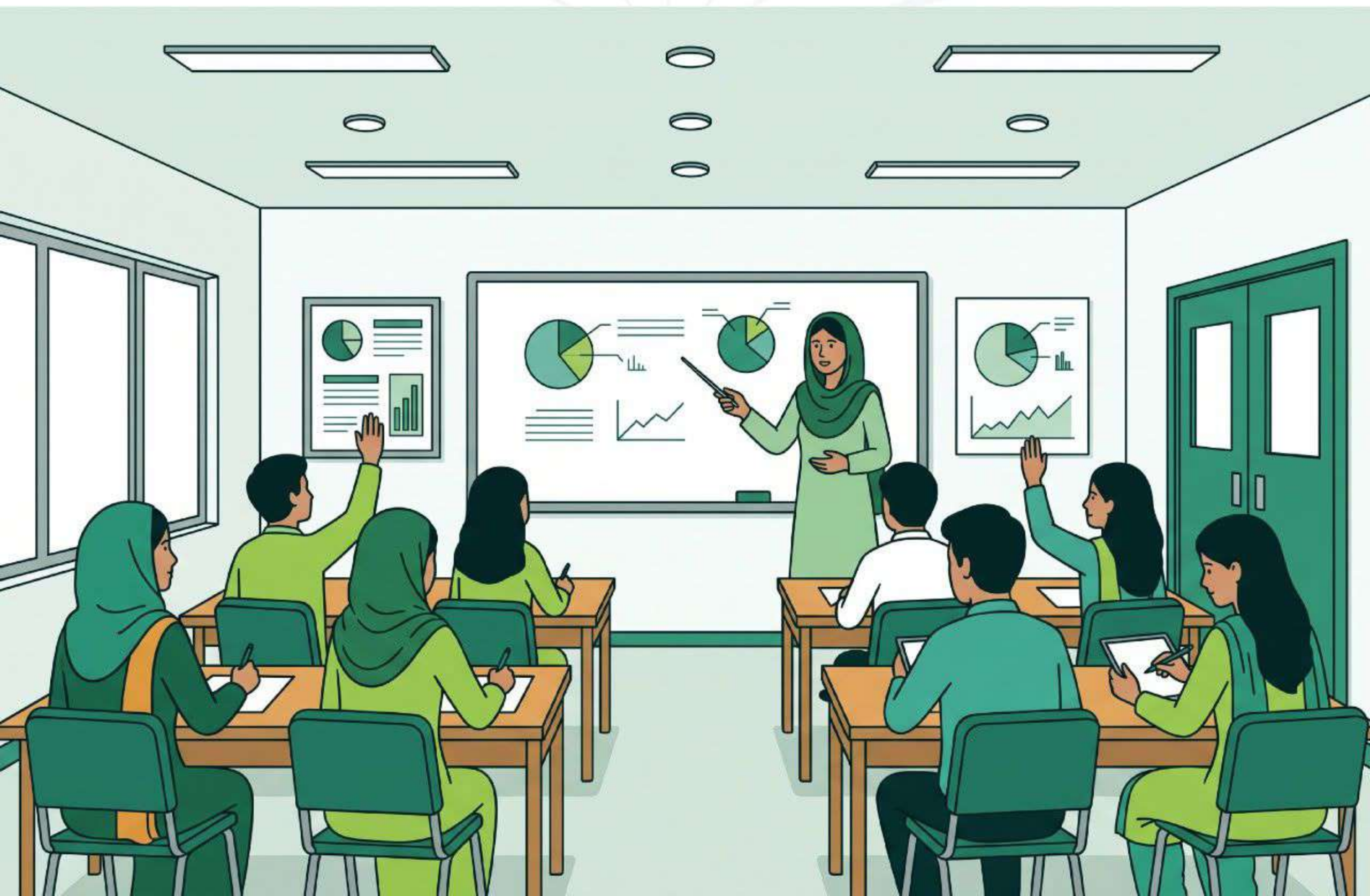

A NEW ACADEMIC JOURNEY COLLEGE REGULAR CLASSES

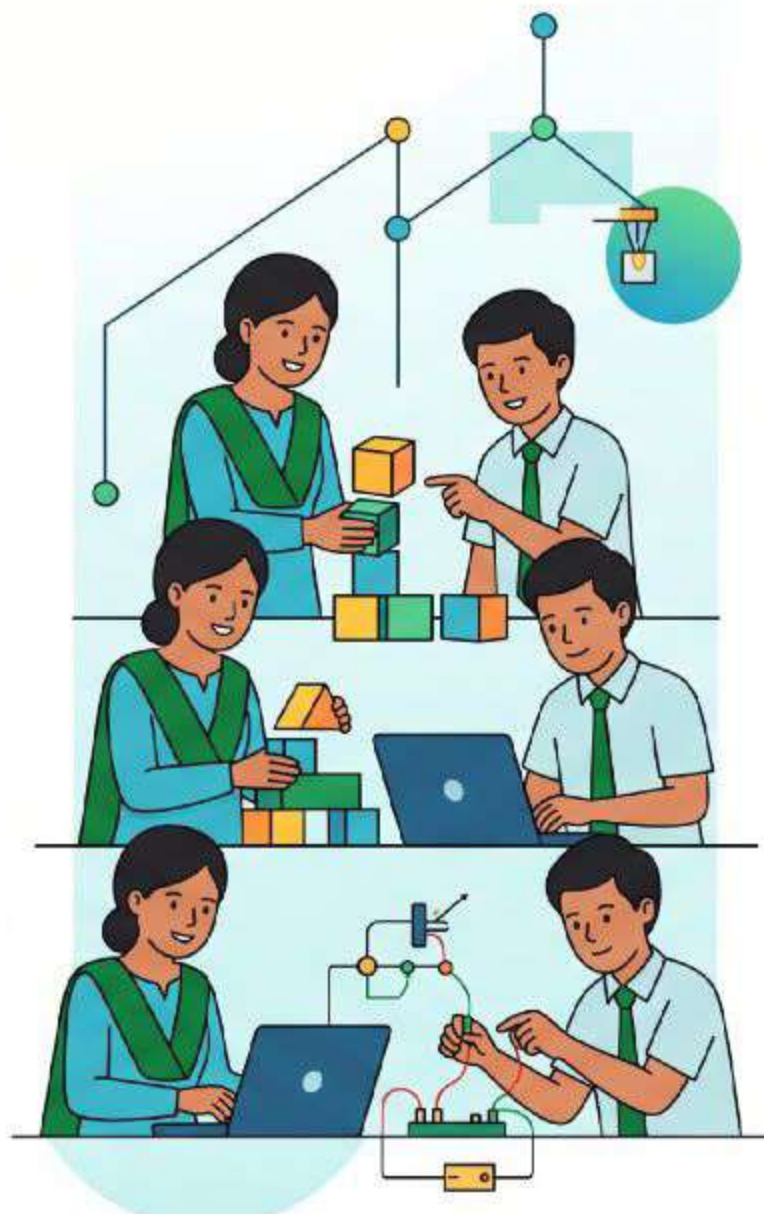
Regular classes at the college have commenced, marking an important step forward in the academic year. Students are expected to approach their college studies with seriousness, consistency, and an active desire to learn.
