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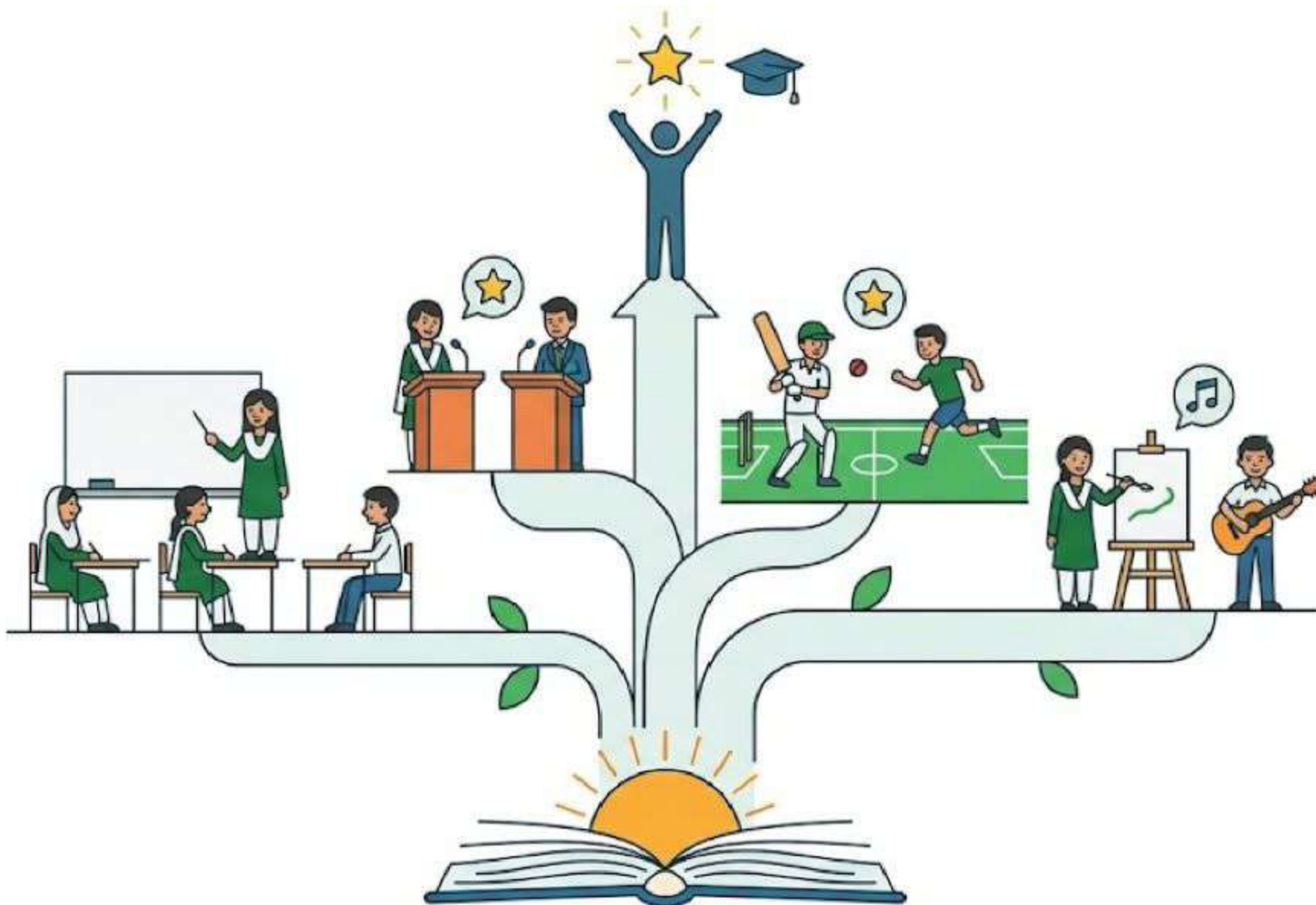


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GROWING WITH PURPOSE, LEARNING WITH CONFIDENCE

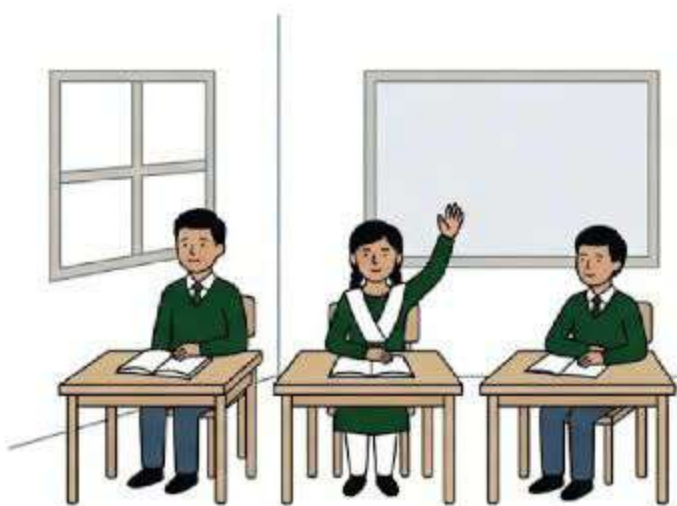


PUNCTUALITY & REGULARITY: THE FOUNDATION OF DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to follow the prescribed winter uniform guidelines and maintain a neat and appropriate appearance throughout the school day. Proper uniform is an important aspect of school discipline and personal presentation.





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COMPETITION CORNER: CHALLENGE YOUR KNOWLEDGE

Leaders' Odyssey School is pleased to inform parents and students about the upcoming HRCA English and Science Competitions and the International Kangaroo Linguistics Contest (IKLC). These competitions provide students with opportunities to test their knowledge, strengthen their skills and experience academic challenges beyond the classroom.

The registration details are as follows:

HRCA English and Science Competitions

- Eligible classes: 1 to 12
- Registration fee: Rs. 1,100
- Last date for submission: 2nd October 2026

International Kangaroo Linguistics Contest (IKLC)

- Eligible classes: 1 to 12
- Registration fee: Rs. 1,100
- Last date for submission: 12th October 2026

Parents are encouraged to motivate their children to participate and make the most of these enriching academic opportunities. Interested students should complete their registration within the respective deadlines.





RESPONSIBLE BELONGINGS: KEEP VALUABLES AT HOME

Students are not permitted to bring money or expensive stationery items to school. Bringing unnecessary valuables can lead to avoidable concerns, including loss, damage or distraction from academic activities.

Parents are requested to ensure that children carry only the stationery and materials required for their daily lessons. Developing responsible habits regarding personal belongings is an important part of a student's discipline and independence.





FEE POLICY: TRANSPARENCY AND TIMELY COMPLIANCE

1. Academic Session for Fee Purposes:

For classes Pre-Nursery to Class X, the academic session shall be from March of the current year to February of the following year. For classes XI & XII, it shall be from June of the current year to May of the following year.

2. Revision of Fee:

The school management reserves the right to revise tuition fees and other applicable charges as and when deemed necessary.

3. Non-Refundable & Non-Transferable:

All fees once paid are strictly non-refundable and non-transferable.

4. Mid-Month Admission:

Students admitted before the 22nd of any academic month will be charged the full monthly fee for that month.

5. Fee Voucher & Due Date:

- a) Fee vouchers will be issued on the 28th of each month.
- b) Fees are payable by the 6th of the following month.
- c) A late payment surcharge of Rs. 1,000/- will be levied after the due date.
- d) If the due date falls on a public holiday, the payment date will be adjusted accordingly.
- e) The challan form is available on the school app.

6. Consequence of Non-Payment:

- a) Failure to pay fees by the due date will result in temporary blocking of the student's school app account and removal from the official school WhatsApp group.
- b) Failure to pay fees for two consecutive months will lead to expulsion of the student from the school.

7. Mode of Payment:

- a) Online Payment: All online fees must be deposited into the official Leaders' Odyssey School & College Account. After payment, parents must share the transaction receipt on the official school WhatsApp number along with Student's Name, ID, Class, and Fee Month.
- b) Cash Payment: Cash payments must be submitted directly at the Accounts Department of the school.

8. Sibling Concession:

A 25% concession on tuition fee is available from the third sibling onwards, as per the school's policy.

9. Annual Result and Clearance:

Fees for the months of January and February must be cleared before the issuance of the Annual Result Card.

10. Advance Collection of Fees:

Fees for January and February of the next academic session will be collected in advance. Therefore, double fees will be charged in the months of November and December.

11. End of Academic Year Charges:

If a student completes his/her academic year at the school, fees for January and February shall remain payable regardless of the notice period. The Annual Result Card and School Leaving Certificate (SLC) will only be issued after clearance of all dues, including fees for January and February.

12. Withdrawal Policy:

If parents/guardians wish to withdraw their child's admission before the 22nd of any month, they will be required to pay the fee for the subsequent month.

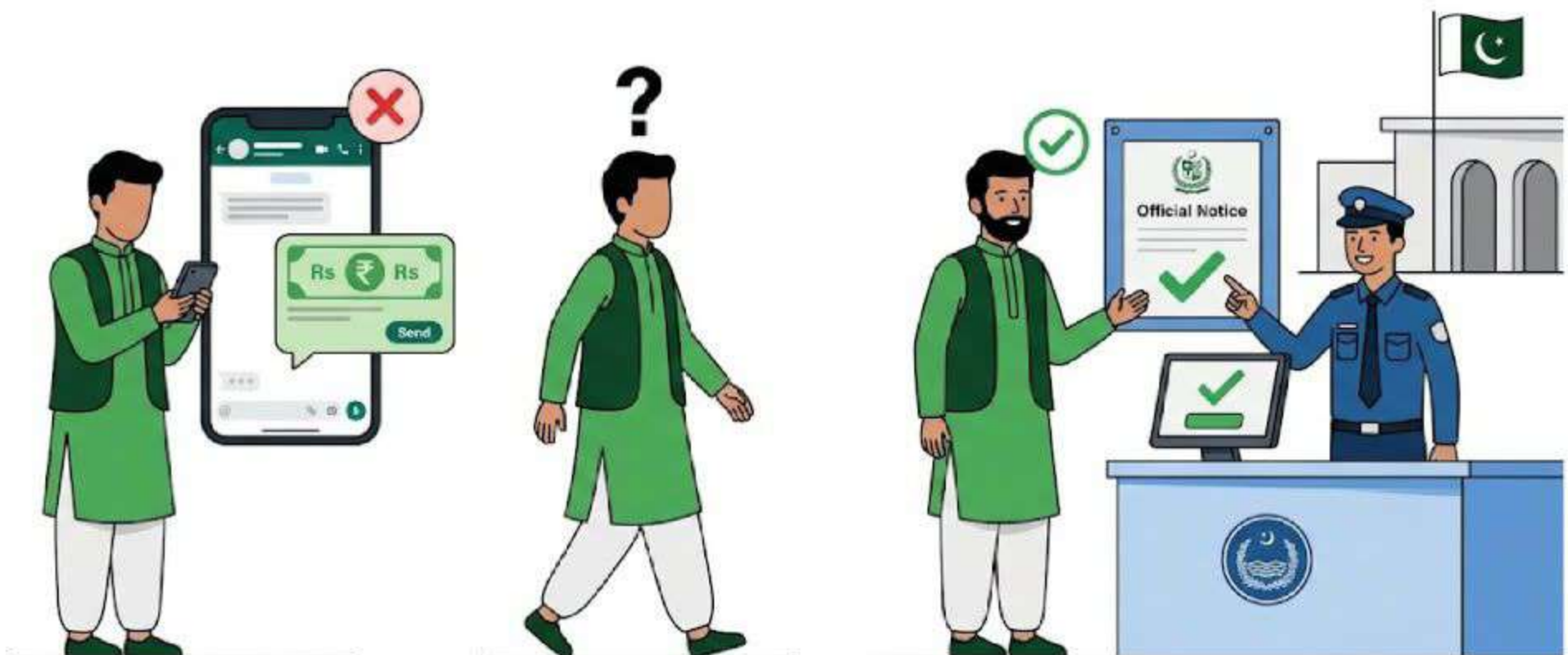


OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION: VERIFY BEFORE YOU PAY

Parents are strongly advised not to send any money to the school in response to WhatsApp group messages unless an official notice has been issued by the school administration.

All financial instructions and payment requests must be verified through the school's authorised communication channels. This precaution helps prevent misunderstandings and ensures that payments are made through the proper procedures.

We value the trust of our parent community and encourage everyone to seek confirmation from the administration whenever an unfamiliar payment request is received.
